WHAT IS NUPSA?

PYLC is an initiative of the National Union of Pakistani Students and Alumni (NUPSA), a student run body that connects Pakistan societies of major universities across the UK and Pakistan. NUPSA aims to achieve the following:

- Student Unity
- Student Support and Welfare
- Provision of Funds to Charities in the interest of Pakistan
- Provision of a United Pakistani student voice to any relevant body (e.g. media or university)
- To build a bridge between current students and alumni and to provide networking opportunities for members

Over 25 Pakistani Societies at UK universities are part of NUPSA including University of Oxford, University of Cambridge, Imperial College, University of Warwick, London School of Economics, University College London and King's College London.



WHAT IS PYLC?

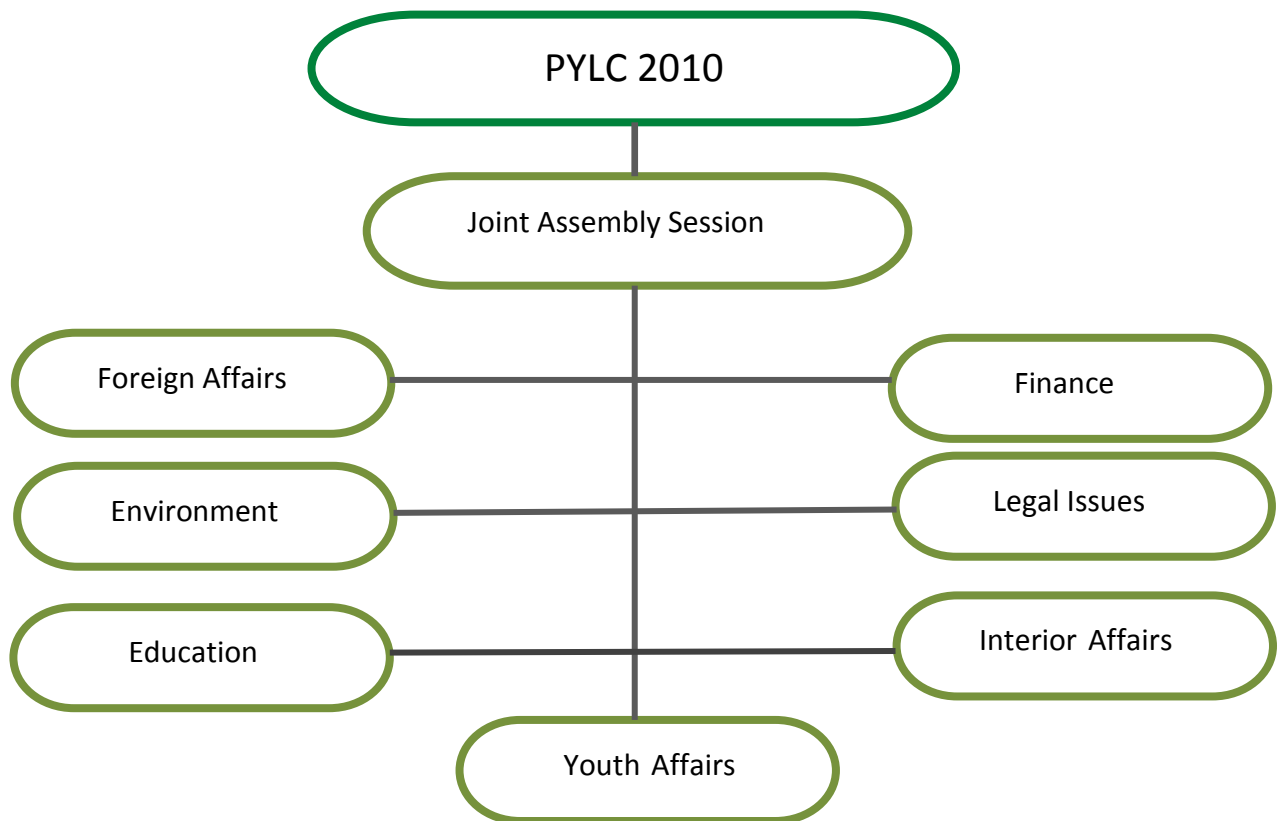
PYLC is a leadership development program that aims to bring together outstanding young people from around the country and help them build critical leadership skills that will help them groom in to successful leaders of the future.

This program gives the participants a greater understanding of their roles as national ambassadors and will serve as a platform for the youth to think about problems facing Pakistan and propose possible solutions.



FORMAT OF PYLC 2010

PYLC will have 7 committees which are designed to discuss possible resolutions for the 7 pertinent problems faced by Pakistan. The resolutions will then be debated in the Joint Assembly Session and the final document will be presented to the policy makers.



PYLC 2009 SUCCESS

PYLC '09 was a first of its kind summit in Pakistan in which Pakistani students from Harvard, Oxford, Cambridge and all the major national Universities took part. The summit was aired on the most popular national current affairs program "Live with Talat", ranging over two episodes.

PYLC's proposal on NFC awards for the provinces was discussed with the Punjab Finance Minister and will be included in the legislation of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.

By bringing together the youth of a country struck by turmoil, PYLC is in itself a Social Responsibility Programme. Providing a platform for the next generation of Pakistanis to come forward and plan the future of the country is the greatest contribution PYLC is making to the Pakistani society. PYLC '10 has therefore included various other initiatives as parts of its agenda to convert its vision in action. The following are some of the activities delegates in Pakistan will be involved in as part of the conference.

- As a contribution to solving the Global Warming problem, PYLC is arranging a special walk on a mountain track in Islamabad on the 31st of January 2010. This will form part of a larger campaign to encourage the government to pass environment friendly regulations and to create awareness amongst the Pakistani population of the adverse environmental effects of everyday actions.
- A group of delegates will take part in a plantation initiative where they will plant trees and plants in the Green Belt of the F/10 Area in Islamabad. This act will mark the start of a long-term programme for environmental preservation.
- The Youth Committee will spend time with members of an orphanage, take care of them and distribute gifts and necessities to them. This initiative is aimed at creating awareness amongst the delegates in order to ensure that the experience gap between the masses and the leaders of tomorrow is minimized.
